# Laureate Member - Bartley Oliver

## Native of San Francisco



**Bartley Oliver, (1854-1945) wealthy San Francisco businessman, very generous to the Catholic Church, and especially to the St. Vincent de Paul Society, contacted Concilium because of an article he read in a Catholic Newspaper about the Legion of Mary running a hostel for homeless men in Dublin. Frank Duff sent Celia Shaw to San Francisco in 1933 to fully explain to Mr. Oliver the scope of the Legion of Mary.**

## First Praesidium Established at Saint Monica Church (1933)



**During Celia Shaw's stay in San Francisco, Fr. William Cantwell, pastor of St. Monica's Church in SF founded the first praesidium in San Francisco on November 14, 1933 for women, and later a praesidium for men and a junior praesidium. Because of his example other parishes founded praesidia – St. Agnes in 1936, Fr. John Kelly of St. Leander's Church, in San Leandro started a Junior praesidium and also a Senior praesidium in 1936, the first in Alameda County.**

# Most Holy Redeemer (1937)



**A praesidium was founded at Most Holy Redeemer in 1937. Mary Foudy, later SF Comitium secretary and then president joined the praesidium at Most Holy Redeemer in 1938.**

## **Envoyship of the Legion Started at the “City by the Bay”**

**Shortly after Celia Shaw’s visit Mr. Oliver wrote to Concilium to offer to fund the first Legion envoys to America to start the Legion of Mary -- Mary Duffy came from Ireland and spread the Legion throughout the western USA and John Murray in the east.**

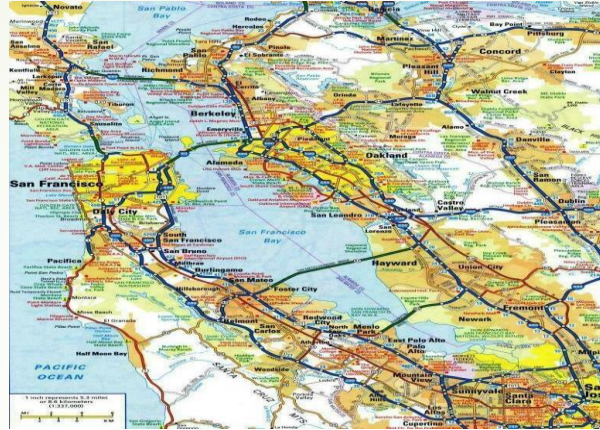

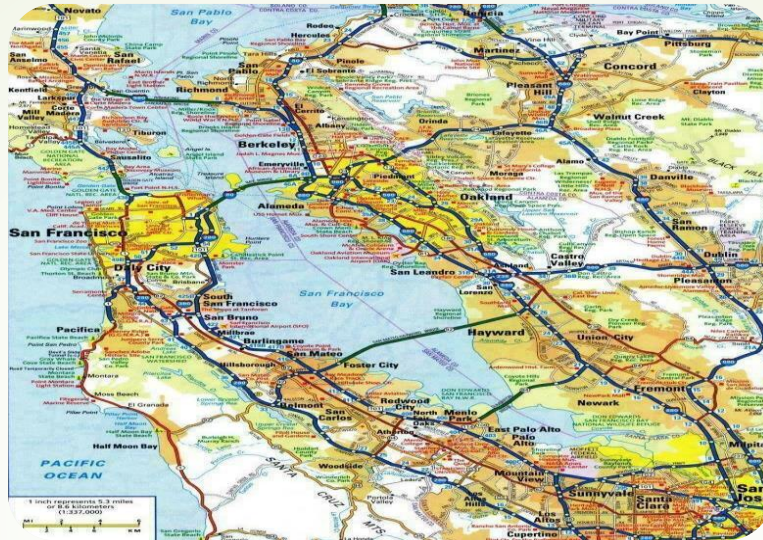

**In 1941 Alameda County Curia was formed and the San Francisco Curia raised to a Comitium. Clara Coghlan elected Comitium president, and Mary Foudy secretary. Fr. Cantwell was Spiritual Director until 1952. On Dec. 7, 1941 Rev. Francis Ripley, expert on the Legion of Mary from England, spoke to Legionaries gathered at St. Monica's.**

**In 1943 the San Francisco and the Alameda County Curia celebrated the tenth anniversary of the Legion of Mary in the archdiocese. Ruth Povey succeeded Clara Coghlan as Comitium president serving until 1953. Fr. James O'Connor was spiritual director from 1952 to 1963.**

# They Left Their Hearts in San Francisco



**Fr. Aedan McGrath** attended a Comitium meeting in 1945 or 1946 on his way to China to spread the Legion of Mary.



In August of 1946 **Joaquina Lucas**, 1<sup>st</sup> Legion envoy to Mexico was traveling from Manila and stopped in San Francisco and attended the San Francisco Comitium meeting. From Mexico she went to South America where she learned Portuguese. She was already fluent in Spanish. Later she was envoy to Japan, Indonesia and Korea.

**Mary Foudy president from 1953 to 1959. In the 1950's in addition to the praesidia in San Francisco and Alameda County Curia there were attached praesidia in San Jose, Gilroy, Stockton, Contra Costa and Solano County She learned to drive and bought a car so that she could visit all these. Lorraine Bush was extension chairperson and helped to start praesidia all along the peninsula. Stockton Curia was formed in 1957 and the Contra Costa-Solano Curia formed in 1959.**

# Junior Praesidia in SF High Schools

**Many Catholic high schools had junior Legion praesidia. A Junior Congress was held on May 16, 1954, at Notre Dame High School in San Francisco. The Dominican Sisters at Immaculate Heart Academy started a praesidium for the girls in 1952, one of the members was Eva Pera, who remains in the Legion of Mary to this day, first living in Half Moon Bay now in Idaho, served as Idaho Curia president.**

# Mary Brady of Saint Kevin's Church

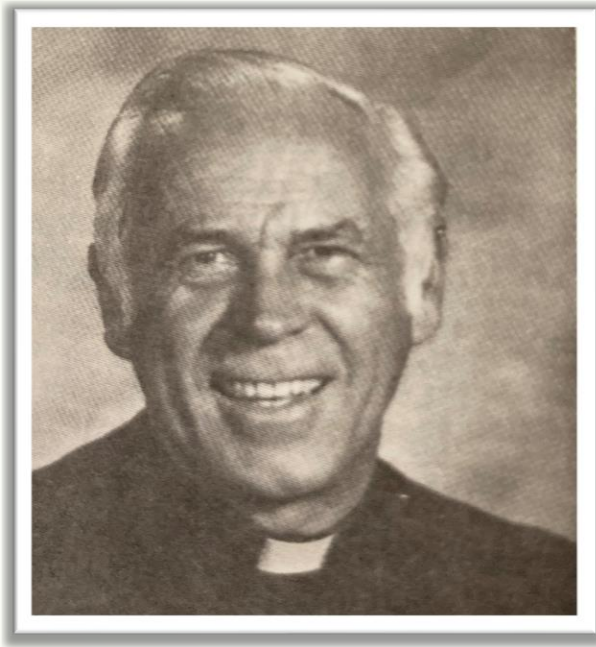


**Outstanding Legion of Mary member Mary Brady of St. Kevin's parish. She served as Comitium president from 1976 to 1982. With her sisters Mary Murphy and Eileen Giannini she visited the Concilium and helped to start the Apostolate to the Crowd in San Francisco, and participated in Peregrinatio Pro Christos in Idaho, Utah, Israel, and even to Russia before the collapse of the Soviet Union. Eileen started English, Spanish and Portuguese praesidia in Half Moon Bay. Several members who moved to Idaho and Oregon started praesidia of the Legion of Mary in their new home parishes.**

## Los Angeles Senatus

**The Los Angeles Senatus was formed in 1958 and the San Francisco Comitium was attached to that Senatus. Formerly the Comitium had reported directly to the Concilium. In February 1959 Mary Foudy and the Oakland Curia president Vicky Cotter attended a meeting of the Los Angeles Senatus.**

## San Francisco Comitium Spiritual Director



**Fr. Howard Rasmussen became Spiritual Director of the Comitium in 1963 and served until 1979 when he became Vicar of the Archdiocese and Fr. Goode took over as Comitium spiritual director.**

## **1960's: A Changing Landscape**

- **In 1961 the San Mateo County Curia was formed.**
- **In 1962 three new Catholic dioceses were formed in Northern California, Santa Rosa, Oakland and Stockton, which reduced the number of counties in the Archdiocese from 13 to 4. New councils were formed in these new dioceses and the Legion in these new dioceses no longer reported to the San Francisco Comitium but rather to the Los Angeles Senatus. As well, Solano County was now a part of the Sacramento diocese**
